Kindergarten – Mrs. Haveman

- Backpack or book bag
- Lunchbox for snacks
- School box for crayons and markers
- Crayons (individually initialed)
- Markers (individually initialed)
- 6-8 Glue sticks (individually initialed and bundled with rubber band)
- Please take crayons and markers out of original boxes and put in school box.
- School provides scissors and pencils.

1st and 2nd grade – Miss. De Jong

- Backpack or book bag – very important!
- Lunch box
- 1 large family size box of tissue
- 3 folders with pockets on each side
- School box or other storage box that will fit inside a desk
- 24 #2 pencils with erasers
- Child size scissors
- Large eraser (very important)
- Glue sticks
- Bottle Elmer's glue
- Crayons (a box of 24 or 36, please do not bring larger boxes)
- 1 box of 12 colored pencils
- Felt tip markers (only 1 small box or package please-**NO** markers that make stamps or shapes)
- 1 pencil sharpener (with cap to catch shavings)
- 1 water bottle
- Please avoid "RoseArt" products, as they tend to break easily.

- 1 70 sheet, **wide rule** spiral bound notebook
- 3 folders with 2 pockets
- One package **Wide rule** loose-leaf notebook paper
- 2 pencil pouches
- 1 box of #2 pencils with erasers
- 1 large eraser
- Pencil sharpener (with cap to catch shavings)
- 1 red ink pen
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box crayons (24-36 count, please nothing larger)
- 1 box markers
- Glue sticks
- Scissors
- Ruler with inches & centimeters (no metal or folding rulers please)

- NIV Bible (5th grade Bible is provided; also available for purchase)
- * **Pocket Accordion File** with at least 6 pockets with a clasp closure and tabs (**Please no binders**. Binders are **NOT** considered successful organizational tools and are difficult to fit properly in desks, backpacks or lockers)
- USB storage device, (min. 1GB)
- Loose-leaf paper **wide rule** (2 packages)
- 3 spiral – bound notebooks **wide rule**
- 2 pocket folders
- 1 pencil pouch
- Pens (blue or black, and red) **note: 7th & 8th grade students will be asked to redo their work if written in any other color**
- 1 box #2 pencils
