The South Island Jet Sports Tour is run in accordance with the New Zealand Jet Sports Boating Association, the International Jet Sports Boating Association 2010 current rule book and any supplementary rules as set by the NZJSBA (copy available on request). Before competing, all riders should familiarize themselves with the rule book fully.

All race events are held at lake Roto Kohatu, Sawyers Arms Rd, Christchurch

Schedule of Events:

9.00am; Registration of competitor entries
 All competitors should be on site no later than 9.00am
 Late arrival may incur race point penalties

9am – 10am Scrutineering/safety check of ski and riders safety equipment
 Your ski is given a safety check and your safety equipment including life jacket and helmet
 are checked for wear and tear.

10am Riders Briefing.
 Competitors riding at each event MUST attend riders briefing. The official race director will
 brief you on the course and any safety aspects.

10.30am approximate time that Daily race schedule commences.

3.30-4pm approximate finish time.

Race Licenses

All competitors must hold a current NZJSBA Race License or apply for a day license. You can apply for licenses at any NZJSBA sanctioned event/South Island Tour event.

- Full NZJSBA Race License (Nov – Oct) \$100.00
- Second Family Member \$ 50.00
- Winter race License (May – October) \$ 60.00
- Day License NB Only a maximum of 2 day licenses can be taken in one year \$ 25.00
- First Time competitors receive one complimentary day license
- If you are applying for a license for the first time please bring along a photocopy of photo ID plus the original matching ID for officials to view.
- If you are under 18yrs, your license Must be signed by a parent or guardian

You MUST hold a full license to compete at the New Zealand Nationals Event.

Minimum age to race is 15 years as per NZ maritime regulations however special exemptions are available to race stock ski (stand up) junior class at 13-15 years. Please contact a committee member for details and requirements needed for exemptions. Exemptions do not happen overnight so please plan ahead.

Once you apply for your full license you will receive a license identification card, competition rule book and copy of NZ supplementary rules.

Race format

Each class competes in four separate races per day (four rounds). Points are accumulated from each race to find overall placing for each day. At the end of the tour, each day's race points are collated for overall tour championship. For South Island Champs, points from each day of racing are accumulated to find overall champs. NB you can gain points on Sunday for both South Island Tour and Champs combined.

A sausage sizzle will be run at the lunch break of each round of the south Island tour/champs. This is complimentary to competitors.

HSR Benilli

Apart from the current S4 models, NO new models of the HSR Benilli will be homologated and therefore unable to compete in any NZJSBA sanctioned event – Summer Tour & Champs, NZ Jet Sport Nationals or club events.
