GP AFRICA AREA

Cameroon:

Africa Area Director Bob and Brenda Bagley sent the following report and prayer requests:

Earlier this month Assistant Africa Area Director Fred Cromer visited the work in Cameroon and reported that the rented facilities were filled to capacity, a number of lay leaders were being trained, and the young congregation has a vision to plant a daughter church in the near future.

- ✘ Pray for God to provide larger facilities where the church can meet.
- ✘ Pray for God's direction and open doors as the church lays the groundwork for a daughter congregation.
- ✘ Several former Muslims are a part of this young church and face persecution from their families. Pray for God to protect them and help them be consistent witnesses to their families.

GP ASIA AREA

Northeast India:

The Northeast regional conference held its 24th annual meeting from February 11-14. The region is made up of five districts with more than 40 churches. Forty-two delegates participated, and 300-600 people attended the worship services. The region is not without its challenges, but they believe with God that the best is yet to come. Pray for them as they face these challenges. Pray for the Holy Spirit to guide and direct the new regional superintendent (name omitted for security) that was just elected. Also, the women leaders, in particular, are passionate about sending local missionaries to reach tribal people. Pray for these missionaries as they reach out to people who have yet to hear the good news.

GP EUROPE AREA

Czech Republic:

The following report is from missionaries Phil and Kristy Boardman:

We have about 60 students coming regularly to our spring English programs. We believe that God has allowed these students to come to our classes, and we want to do all we can to share God's love with them in some way. For many, it is their first interaction with a Christian.

We had a Valentine's party for our students. Marian Graham, missionary and teacher, shared about the English word "love." She shared that Americans say we love everything; pizza, cats, our mothers. But the real love in her life is for God. It was great to see students listen to someone talk about such a deep love for God. Pray that seeds were planted.

GP IBERO-AMERICA AREA

Nicaragua:

According to missionaries Jim and Julie Eckhardt, evangelistic services were held at the Matagalpa church, and 29 people made commitments to the Lord. Praise God! Pray for the evangelistic teams that will be holding services through the district every three weeks up to Easter.

GP PACIFIC AREA

New Zealand:

On February 22 at 12:51 p.m. in New Zealand, Christchurch was struck by an earthquake that caused extensive damage. Currently, there are over 65 deaths and 100 people missing. The Wesleyan Methodist Church of New Zealand has no churches in Christchurch, but plans for a church plant in 2012 will continue. National Superintendent Rev. Dr. Richard Waugh says:

The city has been hit very hard, and Prime Minister John Key has suggested this might be one of New Zealand's darkest days. The prayers of Wesleyans around the globe are greatly appreciated.

- ✘ Pray that those who are trapped will be rescued alive, and pray that rescue workers will be safe.
- ✘ Pray for people who have lost family members, friends, homes, and places of employment.
- ✘ Pray that the people of God will be able to bring the love and peace of Jesus to a community in shock.
- ✘ Pray for pastors and church leaders as they help their community.
