Five students graduated on January 14 from the Bible school extension in Oaxaca! Bob travelled to the graduation to see his students receive their diplomas and be consecrated for ministry in The Wesleyan Church of Mexico. Four of these students are currently pastoring churches, and the fifth will be appointed to one this year. A total of nineteen students and pastors have graduated in Mexico since August 2008!
