GP ASIA AREA

Cambodia:

Missionaries Greg and Resie Fernandez sent the following praise update:

The four-day children's ministry workshop held at the Wesleyan Bible Institute in February was a success. Thirty pastors' wives and Sunday school teachers attended and were greatly blessed. The Word of God was preached; teaching techniques were taught; and the presence of the Holy Spirit was evident in our midst. On the last day the participants actually taught more than 80 children from the community, applying the lesson they had just learned. Pray for these pastors' wives and Sunday school teachers as they apply what they have learned in their church ministries.

Last Sunday, on February 27, five university students came to our first English Bible study session. Some of them go to church occasionally. While they admitted openly that they are not Christians, they came because they want to study English lessons about God and the Bible. Pray that these students would come to a personal relationship with God.

Guyana:

Pray for missionary Doris Wall who is currently in Georgetown working with others to make final revisions in the Patamuna translation of the New Testament. This translation will bring the Living Word to the people in the interior of Guyana in their own language.

Haiti:

Caribe Atlantic Area Director Dan & Joy Irvine sent these requests:

- ☞ Pray for the plans for the new hospital to be built on LaGonave. Soil samples have been collected and a site chosen. Clearing and levelling for the foundation has started.
- ☞ In the aftermath of last year's devastating earthquake, Wesleyan churches continue to be rebuilt at a good pace. Continue to pray for the rebuilding process. At this point, teams are scheduled to rebuild churches through this fall.
- ☞ Last year, Haiti's presidential elections were unresolved. Pray for the elections that are scheduled to take place again on March 20.
- ☞ In the midst of the spiritual renewal that took place after last year's earthquake, Carnival was cancelled. However, plans are in full swing for this year's Carnival. Pray for all of those, especially young people, who will be tempted to participate.

GP EUROPE AREA

The following requests were compiled by Europe Area Director Dennis and Gwen Jackson:

- ☞ Pray for the national church in the United Kingdom as they strive to build the ministry in this time when the powers of darkness are working from within and without.
