

### **WHAT TO BRING TO COVENANT POINT**

- Clothing for the season, including light jacket/sweatshirt (nights can get chilly)
- Tennis/hiking shoes plus river shoes (sandals are discouraged)
- Swimsuit (no bikinis, thongs or Speed-os) and towel
- Rain gear
- Sleeping bag or sheets (twin) and blanket
- Pillow
- Towel
- Personal hygiene items (no aerosols)
- Flashlight and batteries
- Bible
- Alarm clock
- Watch
- All necessary medication (including non-prescription). This must be kept by the camp nurse or director unless for emergency use, such as an asthma inhalator.
- Bug spray (no aerosols)
- Sunscreen

### **OPTIONAL ITEMS**

- Stationery and stamps
- Downtime materials (books, magazines, etc.)
- Camera and film

### **DO NOT BRING**

- CELL PHONES!
- Food or snacks (in order to discourage rodents and insects, food is not permitted in the cabins)
- Anything expensive or valuable
- Electronic devices (radios, video games, MP3 players, DVD players, TVs, laser pointers or anything that plugs in)
- Spending money - there is no soda machine or camp store with items for sale
- Firearms, fireworks or weapons
- Drugs or alcohol
- Tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, etc.)
- Pets

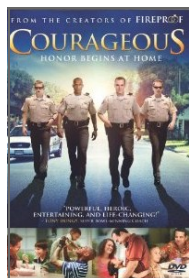

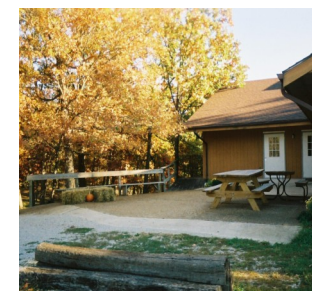
