Members of the UK India Skills Forum met in London on 23rd April to discuss their activity for the year ahead. Amongst the outcomes were the setting of concrete targets, preparing a “compelling proposition” document to market UK skills providers, and a plan for Skills Forum members to attend the FICCI Skills Summit in New Delhi in August.
