



Bring HOLLYWOOD to Your Hometown

Here's how:

BIG IDEA to BEAT OUTLINE is an intimate and interactive, two-day and two-evening weekend screenwriting intensive. Friday evening from 7pm to 10pm, Saturday and from 9am to 10pm including a film screening that evening complete with pizza and popcorn! Sunday runs from 9am to 7pm. The seminar is limited to ten writers so each receives individualized attention and feedback.

The cost is \$395 per person. All meals, snacks and beverages from coffee, juice and bagels in the morning to take out lunches are included for an additional \$40.

Be the "Guy on the Ground" who sets it all up: Promote the seminar to fellow writers and local screenwriting groups, find the location and facilitate with meals and menus. If you fill the class, you receive half-off the tuition or a 1½-hour script consult. If you partner with one other individual person, each person receives \$100 off tuition.

When an Organization sets up the seminar: The organization promotes the seminar to members, local media and throughout the community. A two-hour Thursday evening talk including a Q & A can be arranged and made available to members or to the public to promote the group. The organization provides the appropriate space for the event and seminar. The evening event can be offered free to members or used as a fundraiser to support the organization's efforts.

What we need: We look for a space where we can comfortably sit in a circle on chairs and/or couches. This can be a classroom, conference room, a nonprofit that would like to receive a modest donation or a hotel suite, sound stage or private home. A private home is actually an excellent setting for the relaxed atmosphere of this seminar.

We will also need a DVD player and a large or flat screen TV.
