Fact Sheet

Tarryl Clark has served in the MN State Senate from January 2006-present.

2006

Voted FOR a constitutional amendment which raised the state sales tax by 3/8 of one percent. (Minnesota Senate, S.F. 2734, SJ4525, April 3, 2006)

2007

Voted FOR the Omnibus Transportation Bill for 2008 and 2009 totaling \$4,180,102,000 - raising taxes by up to \$500 a year for a family of four. (Minnesota Senate, S.F. 1971, SJ8870. April 21, 2008)

Voted FOR Omnibus tax bill that included tax increases (Minnesota Senate, H.F. 2268, SJ6325, May 21, 2007)

Voted FOR Omnibus tax bill that included massive income tax increases. (Minnesota Senate, H.F. 2294, SJ3935, May 10, 2007)

Voted FOR massive income tax increases and the creation of a 4th income tax bracket. (Minnesota Senate, S.F. 1611, SJ1927, March 31, 2007)

2008

Voted FOR \$6.6 billion transportation bill that increased the sales tax, gas tax, and vehicle registration tax (Minnesota Senate, H.F. 2800, SJ 6648, February 21, 2008)

Voted FOR the Legacy Amendment which imposes 3/8 percent sales tax on Minnesota. (Minnesota Senate, H.F. 2285, SJ6500, February 14, 2008)

2009

Voted FOR omnibus tax bill that included increases in sales tax. (Minnesota Senate, S.F. 2074, SJ2754, April 24, 2009)

Voted FOR a \$1 billion tax increase that included a fourth tier tax increase, liquor tax increase, and a cigarette tax increase. (Minnesota Senate, H.F. No. 885, 2009, Senate Journal 4466, May 8, 2009)

Voted FOR end of session omnibus tax bill that included increases in sales tax. (Minnesota Senate, S.F. 2074, SJ6730, May 18, 2009)

2010

Voted FOR bill to increase income tax rates. (Minnesota Senate, H.F. 2037, SJ10867, May 10, 2010)

Voted FOR authorization for several local option sales tax changes including higher food, beverage, and lodging taxes. (Minnesota Senate, S.F. 3327, SJ12051, May 15, 2010)
