

Understanding the Democrat majority's abuse of power

Topline: Democrats are determined to impeach this president even though the “facts” are invalid and the rules are unfair. House Democrats are abusing their power. The motive, means, and opportunity of their offense is clear.

Motive: The 2020 presidential election

- Democrats refuse to accept the outcome of the 2016 election, and they will do everything in their power to prevent President Trump from winning again—including impeachment.
- Democrats are moving at a breakneck pace in order to finish impeachment before Christmas in the House and before the Iowa caucuses in the Senate.

Means: An unfair sham impeachment inquiry

- Speaker Pelosi broke the rules of her own majority in order to ram through an impeachment that disregards fairness and silences all voices of opposition.
- Chairman Schiff empowered himself to control and misdirect the narrative when he:
 - Made up a version of the call between Presidents Trump and Zelensky;
 - Prevented witnesses from answering questions from Republican lawmakers;
 - Hand-picked witnesses; and
 - Leaked cherry-picked information.
- The facts do not align with Democrats' spin, so they follow presumptions instead of proof, falsehoods instead of facts.
 - Prof. Turley testified, “Presumption is no substitute for proof.” He added, “The current legal case for impeachment is not just woefully inadequate, but in some respects, dangerous, as the basis for the impeachment of an American president.”

Opportunity: November 2018, Democrats take the House

- For each of the last 3 years, Democrats have introduced resolutions to impeach President Trump. This year, they used their majority to force an unfair impeachment through the People's House.
- Democrats are trying to nullify the votes of 63 million Americans.
- Democrats gave themselves a deadline of the end of the year to impeach the president.
- This impeachment is about a clock and a calendar—not the facts.

4 facts that never change

- Both President Trump and President Zelensky say there was no pressure.
- The call transcript shows no conditionality between aid and an investigation.
- Ukrainians were not aware that aid was withheld when the presidents spoke.
- Ukraine didn't open an investigation, but still received aid and a meeting with President Trump.
