SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SEEK MEMBERS TO SERVE ON BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES

Application Deadline is October 5, 2018

San Joaquin County – September 13, 2018 – The Board of Supervisors is seeking volunteers to serve on the following boards and commissions.

The deadline to submit applications is **Friday, October 5**. The Board of Supervisors will consider qualified applications, received on or before the deadline, at the Board meeting of November 6.

All members appointed by the Board of Supervisors will be required to attend training. Training dates and registration information will be provided by the Clerk of the Board upon appointment.

- **Boggs Tract Community Center Advisory Board – 4 Positions**

All members must reside in the Boggs Tract Community Center service area and be at least 16 years of age.

- One (1) At-Large Representative, Position No. 1501
- Three (3) Low-Income Representatives, Position Nos. 1503.1; 1503.2; 1503.4

- **California Correctional Health Care Facility's Citizen's Advisory Committee – 1 Position**

- One (1) Board of Supervisors Nominee, Position No. 6801.1

- **Council for Quality Education and Care of Children – 3 Positions**

All new applicants must complete a Supplemental application prior to being appointed and must attend one Council for Quality Education and Care of Children regular meeting within the 3 months *prior* to being appointed to the Council.

- Two (2) Child Care Provider Representatives, Position Nos. 2501.2 and 2501.3, defined as a person who provides child care services or represents persons who provide child care services.
- One (1) Public Agency Representative, Position No 2505.2, defined as person(s) who represents a city, county, city and county, or local education agency.

- **Garden Acres Community Center Advisory Board – 2 Positions**

All members must reside in the Garden Acres Community Center service area and be at least 16 years of age.

- One (1) At-Large Representative, Position No. 3001
- One (1) Community Service Organization Representative, Position No. 3002.1. Applicants for this position must include an official nomination letter from an organization or group that operates in the center's geographic service area.

- **Kennedy Community Center Advisory Board – 3 Positions**

All members must reside in the Kennedy Community Center service area and be at least 16 years of age.

- Two (2) Community Service Organization Representatives, Position Nos. 4002.1 and 4002.2. Applicants for this position must include an official nomination letter from an organization or group that operates in the center's geographic service area.
- One (1) Low-Income Representative, Position No. 4003.3

- **Lodi Community Center Advisory Board – 2 Positions**

All members must reside in the Lodi Community Center service area and be at least 16 years of age.

- Two (2) Low-Income Representatives, Position Nos. 4503.1 and 4503.2

- **Northeast Community Center Advisory Board – 3 Positions**

All members must reside in the Northeast Community Center service area and be at least 16 years of age.

- One (1) At-Large Representative, Position No. 5001
- Two (2) Low-Income Representative Representatives, Position Nos. 5003.1 and 5003.2

- **Resource Conservation District – 4 Positions**

Directors shall be registered voters of the State and shall 1) reside within the District and either own real property in the District or alternatively have served pursuant to the Districts rules, for 2 years or more as an Associate Director providing advisory or other assistance to the Board of Directors, or 2) be a designated agent of a resident landowner within the District.

- Four (4) Directors, Position Nos. 5401.1; 5401.2; 5401.3; 5401.4

- **Taft Community Center Advisory Board – 1 Position**

All members must reside in the Taft Community Center service area and be at least 16 years of age.

- One (1) At-Large Representative, Position No. 6201
- One (1) Community Service Organization Representative, Position No. 6202.1 Applicants for this position must include an official nomination letter from an organization or group that operates in the center's geographic service area.
- One (1) Low-Income Representative, Position 6203.2

- **Tracy Public Cemetery District Board of Trustees –1 Position**

All Members must reside within the district, be a qualified voter of the State, and upon appointment complete a Form 700 – Statement of Economic Interest.

- One (1) Director, Position No. 6501.4
